Open to all Eagle Scouts currently registered in an active unit and have not reached their 19th birthday during the application year.

(The application year is January 1 to December 31)

The scout must fill out a two page application, write a 500 word essay on a patriotic theme, and complete a four generation ancestor chart (back to the Scout's Great Grandparents). The family chart is to introduce the scout to the importance of knowing his family history.
